PURCHASING YOUR TICKETS

We understand it's a financial burden to have to purchase tickets to see your child in both shows. We recommend purchasing tickets for the 'main' show your child has the most items to perform in. The acting scenes and solos they are performing are the same for each show however the class dances and songs vary for both shows. Whichever show your child performs most onstage will be the one to see! We have a 'standing room' option for the alternate show which means you are welcome to come and watch in the standing room area (or drop them off for the show and pick them up when it's finished.) **TICKETS ONSALE FRIDAY 8TH NOV**

3. HOW TO BUY A FULL SHOW TICKET (ACT ONE AND ACT TWO)

Adult: \$33.00
Child U14: \$30.00



To purchase a ticket for the whole show, you must select an Act One Ticket and an Act Two Ticket.

This ensures that you get the same seat for both acts, as some people will only have seats for one act, allowing other families to purchase those seats for the next act.

- Follow the 2 steps above to purchase an Act One and Act Two ticket
- At checkout, you should have 2x tickets per person.. 1x Ticket for Act One, 1x Ticket for Act Two
- Use the code **FULLSHOWTICKET** which will change the price to the Full Show Ticket

Seating Options

- 1) Front Row Seating ((Premium views! These seats have a separate price)
- 2) General Seating (All other seats)

3) Standing Room (Parents who have to come to both Sat & Sun concerts: Please purchase seats for one main concert and select 'Multiple Show' standing ticket for the other shows if you do not wish to purchase tickets for both concerts)

Please note Trybooking adds a small ticketing fee

Students who have finished performing in Act One can watch Act Two from our allocated student area or sit on parents' laps

Responsibilities and Tasks of Being a Parent Volunteer:

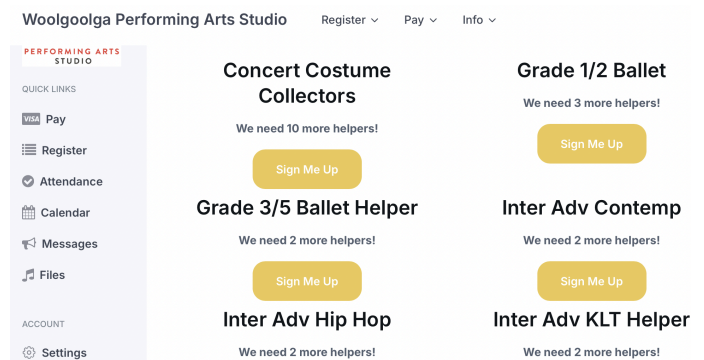
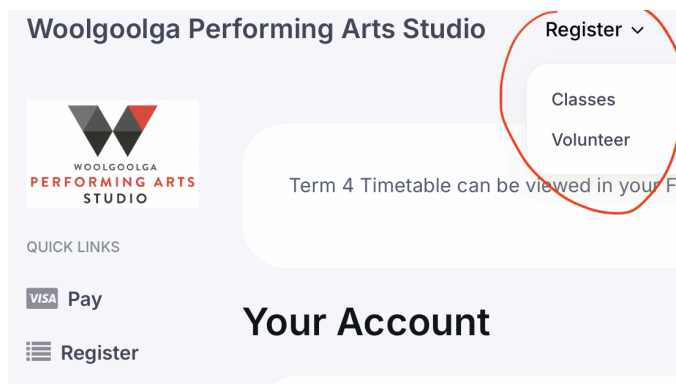
- Costume Management: Ensure all children change into their correct costumes before the performance.

FOOD AND DRINK

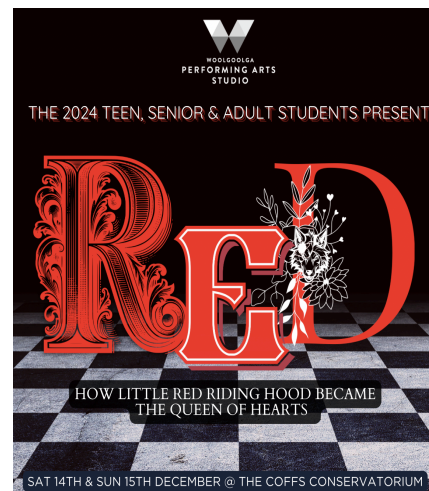

HAIR & MAKEUP TUTORIALS + COSTUME REHEARSAL DAY SUNDAY 17TH NOVEMBER @ WPAS

Welcome to our Costume Rehearsal day for Wonderland!

A day where students learn and understand the process of wearing their costume for their routines, dances and songs. Preparing for and wearing a costume takes practise - and this is the day for it!

We make sure costumes fit well with student's stockings and dance shoes and make any adjustments to customise the costume to your child's body. This service is all included in your costume fee and we also provide the transportation, steaming and preparation of each costume for the performances so that you don't have to!

There are two Hair and Makeup tutorials held this day which are open for all students and parents to attend. We will have a camera set up and a tv screen so that you can see the finer details of how to correctly and effectively do hair and makeup. Every child is unique, how you do their hair and makeup is no different - we can teach you the generic way then help you tailor it to suit your child.

Jack and Tracy will be in the office between 10.00am and 2.00pm for all of your stockings, shoes and WPAS merch needs! It's a great opportunity to come and ask questions and gain more clarity about the Production process.







HAIR & MAKEUP

Stage makeup isn't about trying to make our little ones look 'older' and 'mature.' It's all about enhancing your child's features to match the heightened colours in their sets, costumes and lights around them so that their expression doesn't get lost. Bright stage lights can wash out facial features, making it hard for the audience to see expressions. Makeup helps define the face and enhances visibility from a distance. It also allows performers to embody their characters more fully and learn the process of being a performer onstage!

There are lots of brands that use mineral ingredients and free from toxins and chemicals which are a great option for stage makeup - these are best purchased from a chemist as the supermarkets can be limited. Nude by Nature and INKA are some of the regular brands



MAKEUP STEPS	TIPS
1. Foundation & Concealer (Boys & Girls)	Foundation Tip - If you feel foundation is heavy for your child's face, use a BB cream and 'build' it up. Make sure their foundation isn't lighter than their skin tone as the stage lights will naturally brighten their face. Keep it at their current skintone or a slight shade darker.
2. Eyeshadow (White, tan, gold) (Girls)	Warm Brown Eyeshadow on eyelid, white eyeshadow blended underneath the eyebrow into the brown. Gold or Shimmer can then go over the brown eyeshadow <i>Blending Tip - Use a fluffy eyeshadow brush in small circular motions</i>
3. Black Mascara + Eyebrows (Girls & Boys)	Mascara Tip - have your child close their eyes. Pull up the eyelid gently to apply mascara to the lashes whilst their eyes are closed. If eyebrows are quite fair, use a natural eyebrow pencil colour to darken them only by a shade or two
4. Black Liquid eyeliner (For Jnr / Inter / older students)	Apply Liquid Eyeliner on the top of eyelids finishing slightly off the eye and in an upwards flick
5. Blush / Bronzer (Girls & Boys)	Gently apply pink blush to apples of cheek and extend to hairline. If you have a bronzer / brown tone blush you can also apply this if you feel confident as a contour. Have your child suck in their cheeks and make a fish face, then follow the line underneath their cheekbone.
6. Bright Red Lipstick / Lip Balm (Girls & Boys)	For girls - Because the lights and our costumes are bright and colourful, wearing bright lipstick enhances our features with the setting of being onstage without having to add any heavy makeup. Lipstick Tip - for longer wearing, choose a matte lipstick with pawpaw on top so lips don't dry out but the colour doesn't move. Boys - Boys to wear pawpaw / lip balm
HAIR FOR BOYS / MALES	TIPS
	Depending on their comfortability, as long as Boys hair is away from their face that's the most important thing! We encourage boys to style their hair for performance regardless of their hair length (you don't have to cut it shorter if they like it longer.) If their hair is long enough to tie back, you can tie it back and under itself like a bun tuck / 'man' bun.

HAIR STEPS FOR BUNS	TIPS
1. Unwashed hair = best	<p>You would think that having freshly washed hair for a bun is the key however hair that is unwashed and has a little 'grit' in it from a day or two before is the best condition for styling your child's hair.</p>
2. Wet / Dampen Hair 	<p>Wet or dampened hair works best. Spray their hair with a spray bottle of water before brushing their hair</p>
3. Gel 	<p>Gel is your friend! Add a little gel to the top and sides to their hairline, where the fly always escapes. Now, brush their hair back, brushing any excess gel into the wet hair</p>
4. Brush Hair Back 	<p>Use a "smoothing brush" or comb to brush hair into a ponytail. Regular brushes with plastic bristles aren't smooth and create separations in your hair. Any brush with close bristles will brush hair back uniformly and back into a ponytail. When you tie their hair back, ensure the ponytail is in a diagonal line with their chin so that the bun placement isn't too high or too low.</p>
5. Hair ties & Pins 	<p>When you put their hair in a ponytail, use an elastic that matches their hair color and blends in. If you use a colored hair tie, it may be seen under the stage lights.</p> <p>Bobby pins should match hair color too! Blondes, don't use black pins. Brunettes, don't use blonde or metallic pins. Not all bobby pins are the same.. Find a pin that suits their hair type. Smaller pins are better for thin hair. Long jumbo pins work best for thick hair.</p>
6. Twist the ponytail into a bun! 	<p>Twist your ponytail into a rope and wrap it around the hair tie. Be sure to pin the twisted ponytail to your head as you wrap it around. When you bobby pin your bun, pin your hair like numbers on a clock.</p>
7. Hairnet to lock it in place 	<p>Don't forget a hair net! Select a hair net that is similar to your natural hair color and wrap it around the bun after you've pinned it. For dancers with layers in their hair, this will help keep the shorter layers tucked down and not sticking up all over the place. You can also reshape the bun at this stage if it hasn't pinned in a great shape.. Leave the hairnet tight around the bun and re pin the hair to create the shape</p>
8. Hairspray 	<p>Seal the deal with a small spritz of hairspray to keep it from moving around and getting messy during costume changes.</p> <div style="display: flex; justify-content: space-around; align-items: center;">    </div>

Avoiding burnout during production week for young performers

What Is Performance Burnout?

Burnout isn't just about being physically exhausted from too many routines or choreography. It's when a young performer's initial love and enthusiasm for the show starts to fade, and they find it harder to stay motivated or focused. This can begin to happen due to fatigue—both mental and physical. We know our students and families juggle multiple commitments—school, family, social lives, and hours of rehearsal. With such a packed schedule on top of this, it's easy for burnout to set in.

Students physically pushing themselves too hard can lead to injuries as performer fatigue affects more than just the muscles—it impacts the entire body.

Students can also start to lose their spark, or when the joy they once felt for dancing and performing is replaced by feelings of anxiety, doubt, or pressure. This can lead to a real struggle to maintain motivation and joy in the art form.

Signs to look for with Performance Burnout

- If routines or steps become harder to remember or concentrate on, it might be time for more breaks or altering your schedule (you can always get in touch with us if your child needs more rest) Feeling tired after every rehearsal or show session can indicate overexertion.
- If your performer suddenly shows a lack of interest in food, their body might be under too much stress.
- A dip in motivation or excitement to perform is a key indicator of burnout.
- Increased irritability, anxiety, or sadness can point to stress overload.
- Difficulty bouncing back after tough practices or performances suggests the need for more downtime.

Preventing Performance Burnout

Communication

We will be talking openly with students about how they're feeling through the process of production week. These conversations can help gauge their emotional and physical well-being. If they're stressed or feeling overwhelmed, knowing how to approach these feelings can help both us and you help your child find a solution.

Regular Breaks

Students will have plenty of 'down time' between scenes and routines, whether it's a break between rehearsals or a scheduled time off, rest and recharge is critical for long-term success and enjoyment. On their long days at the theatre we will have spaces created for them to rest / lie down if they need and quiet spaces if they get overstimulated.

Holistic approach

A performer's body thrives on more than just practice—nutrition, sleep, and relaxation are all crucial components of staying healthy and energized. Encourage healthy habits to help maintain both physical and mental well-being.
